

HUNGER IN DOUGLAS COUNTY

Food Insecurity

In Douglas County 6,598 residents are food insecure. This means 1 in 6 of the county's population are unsure of where their next meal will come from.



Food Bank Participation

Food banks receiving funds from the WSDA Food Assistance Program in Douglas and Chelan Counties served 49,015 people in need of food last year. These people visited food banks 170,443 times to get nutritious foods including meats, dairy, produce and grains.

Poverty Rate

In Douglas County it is estimated that over 14% of people are living under the poverty levels. An income at the poverty level is not enough for families and individuals in Washington to survive. According to the USDA Food and Nutrition Services Department the poverty level for a family of 2 is less than \$14,580 a year and \$22,056 for a family of 4.
