

HUNGER IN OKANOGAN COUNTY

Food Insecurity

In Okanogan County 8,275 residents are food insecure. This means 1 in 5 of the county's population are unsure of where their next meal will come from.



Food Bank Participation

Food banks receiving funds from the WSDA Food Assistance Program in Okanogan County served 18,399 people in need of food last year. These people visited food banks 185,717 times to get nutritious foods including meats, dairy, produce and grains.

Poverty Rate

In Okanogan County it is estimated that nearly 20% of people are living under the poverty levels. An income at the poverty level is not enough for families and individuals in Washington to survive. According to the USDA Food and Nutrition Services Department the poverty level for a family of 2 is less than \$14,580 a year and \$22,056 for a family of 4.
