

# HUNGER IN PACIFIC COUNTY

## Food Insecurity

In Pacific County 4,461 residents are food insecure. This means 1 in 5 of the county's population are unsure of where their next meal will come from.



## Food Bank Participation

Food banks receiving funds from the WSDA Food Assistance Program in Pacific and Grays Harbor Counties served 14,752 people in need of food last year. These people visited food banks 139,806 times to get nutritious foods including meats, dairy, produce and grains.

## Poverty Rate

In Pacific County it is estimated that 16.5% of people are living under the poverty levels. An income at the poverty level is not enough for families and individuals in Washington to survive. According to the USDA Food and Nutrition Services Department the poverty level for a family of 2 is less than \$14,580 a year and \$22,056 for a family of 4.
